Directions

Stockade Polo & Saddle Club, Inc. is located at 505 Sacandaga Road (Rte 147) in Glenville, with access just north of the Beukendaal Firehouse.

From Route 29 (points north): Turn on Route 147 heading south. Pass through Galway, cross Route 67 and continue on Route 147 toward Scotia. Show is approximately 9 miles from Route 67, on the right.

From Route 67: Take Route 67 west from Ballston Spa / east from Amsterdam, to Route 147 (traffic light, Stewart's, big white church at intersection). Turn south on Route 147 and proceed 9 miles.

Grounds are less than one mile past Stewart's. Driveway is on the right, just north of the Beukendaal Firehouse, across from Spring Road.

From I-90/Route 890 (points east): Take Route 890 west (from Thruway exit 25 or other access) toward Rotterdam. Continue past Schenectady, Campbell and Rice Roads. Route 890 will take you across the Mohawk River to Route 5. Cross Route 5 (do not turn) and exit 890 straight onto Vley Road. Continue on Vley Road to Route 147 access on the right, immediately after an underpass. Turn right (north) onto Route 147, over bridge (passing back over Vley Road), and look for the Beukendaal Firehouse immediately after the bridge on your left. Turn left in the new driveway just past the firehouse; follow the driveway behind the adjacent property to the show grounds.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Classes will be conducted in accordance with the current CDHJC and TCRA Rule Books. For combined divisions in which CDHJC and TCRA specifications differ, **riders are responsible for understanding their eligibility** and class entry restrictions in order to earn year-end points with each organization.
Rulebooks are available for online reference at www.cdhjc.org and www.tricountyridingassociation.com.
2. All riders must wear properly fitted, protective head gear while mounted on Stockade Polo & Saddle Club, Inc. grounds.
3. All entries will be accepted with the understanding that the management, Stockade Polo & Saddle Club, Inc. and SPSA Associates, LLC will not be responsible for any accident which may occur to any rider, driver, groom or attendants, animal, vehicle or equipment at this horse show.
4. Management reserves the right to decline any entry and return any entrance fees without being liable for compensation.
5. Entry forms must be filled out completely and signed by the rider (parent/guardian if rider is a minor) before numbers will be assigned.
6. Management may combine or cancel any class with insufficient (fewer than 3) entries.
8. Exhibitors must have entered and shown in the Over Fences classes in each division in order to be eligible to compete in the Hunt-and-Go Derby.
9. Warm-up is available, \$20 per horse/rider combination *per show day*. Schooling breaks will be scheduled by fence height.
11. Dogs must be confined or leashed at all times when on the show grounds.
12. Please do not clean out trailers or dump manure or garbage on the grass or in tree lines at Stockade.
13. A processing fee of \$40 will be charged for all checks returned by the bank, for any reason.

Special awards:

High-point Hunter Award to the horse earning the most points in Hunter classes ridden by Junior and/or Amateur riders.

Trainer Award to the trainer whose top three Junior and/or Amateur riders earn the most points in any regular hunter/equitation classes

I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition involve inherent dangerous risk of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death (“Harm”)
- I AGREE to release the Competition, Councils (CDHJC, TCRA), Stockade Polo & Saddle Club Inc (Stockade) and SPSA Associates, LLC from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and any Harm resulting, directly or indirectly, from negligence of Competition, Council, Stockade and/or SPSA.
- I AGREE to expressly assume all risk of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of the Competition, Councils, Stockade and/or SPSA.
- I AGREE to indemnify (that is, to pay any losses, damages, or costs incurred by) the Competition, the Councils, Stockade and/or SPSA and to hold them harmless with respect to claims for Harm to me or my horse, and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my horse at the Competition.
- I acknowledge that the Competition and Stockade require me to wear an ASTM rated safety helmet AT ALL TIMES WHILE ON HORSEBACK, as part of the Competition Rules, while warning that no protective equipment can guard against all injuries.
